HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

This manual is designed for personal discipleship, mentoring, or a small group. Move prayerfully and do not rush merely to finish pages.

1. READ PRAYERFULLY Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand Scripture.	2. STUDY EVERY REFERENCE Open your Bible and read the verses around each passage.
3. ANSWER HONESTLY Allow truth to examine your heart.	4. PRAY AND APPLY Turn insight into immediate obedience.

LESSON OVERVIEW

The Bible tells us who Jesus Christ is. He is the promised Messiah and the Son of God. Scripture calls Him God, the Mighty God, the Alpha and the Omega. He came as a man, lived without sin, did mighty works, died for our sins, and rose from the dead. He is Lord, He is coming again, and He is King of kings. Everyone is called to believe in Him and follow Him.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Know that Jesus is the promised Messiah
- See from Scripture that Jesus Christ is called God
- Understand His sinless life, mighty works, healings, and deliverances
- Know how God commands us to respond to His Son

PRAY BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Father, help me understand Your Word. Show me the truth about Jesus Christ, correct every wrong belief, and help me to believe and obey. Amen.

STUDY COMMITMENT

I will read every passage carefully, answer honestly, allow Scripture to correct me, and act on the truth God shows me.

CHAPTER 1

JESUS IS THE PROMISED MESSIAH

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Isaiah 61:1-2; Luke 4:16-21; John 1:40-42; John 4:25-26

“Messiah” means “Christ,” the One God promised and sent. Andrew said, “We have found the Messias,” and Jesus told the woman of Samaria that He is the Messiah. In Nazareth, Jesus read Isaiah’s promise about the anointed One and said that the Scripture was fulfilled that day.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God’s promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

“Messiah” means “Christ,” the One God promised and sent.

DISCUSS AND OBEY

1. What misunderstanding does this chapter correct?
2. What would obedience to this truth look like this week?
3. How does this truth lead me to trust, love, or follow Jesus Christ more fully?

REFLECTION & PRAYER

Where does this truth confront my present life? Pray specifically, using the language and priorities of the passages.

CHAPTER 2**THE SON OF GOD****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

Luke 1:30-35; Matthew 3:16-17; John 5:22-23

The angel told Mary that the holy Child would be called the Son of God. God also spoke from heaven and called Jesus His beloved Son. Jesus said that everyone should honour the Son just as they honour the Father.

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CHAPTER 3**SCRIPTURE CALLS HIM GOD****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

John 1:1-3, 14; John 20:26-29; Hebrews 1:8; Isaiah 9:6; Revelation 1:8, 17-18

John says that the Word was with God and the Word was God. The Word became flesh and lived among us. Thomas said to Jesus, "My Lord and my God." God spoke of the Son, saying, "Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever." Isaiah called the promised Son "The mighty God." Revelation calls the Lord God "the Almighty," and the One who is the First and the Last says that He was dead and is alive for evermore. Read these passages carefully together.

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CHAPTER 4**SINLESS AND MIGHTY IN WORKS****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

1 Timothy 2:5; Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:22; Matthew 4:23-24; Mark 1:32-34;
Acts 10:38; John 20:30-31

Scripture calls Him “the man Christ Jesus.” He was tempted, yet He did not sin. God anointed Him with the Holy Ghost and power. He healed the sick, cast out unclean spirits, and healed those oppressed by the devil. His signs helped people believe that He is the Christ, the Son of God.

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CHAPTER 5**HE DIED AND ROSE AGAIN**

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES
1 Corinthians 15:1-8; Acts 13:28-39

Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. He was buried and raised on the third day according to the Scriptures. He appeared to many witnesses. Through Him, forgiveness of sins is proclaimed.

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CHAPTER 6**THE ALPHA, OMEGA, AND KING****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

Acts 1:9-11; Acts 4:10-12; Revelation 19:11-16; Revelation 22:12-13, 16, 20

Jesus Christ says, “I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last,” and, “Behold, I come quickly.” He will come again. Scripture calls Him “KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.” We must believe in Him, follow Him, and be ready for His coming.

SEARCH, EXAMINE, AND RESPOND

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Day 1 - Read the key passage and record what it teaches about God.

Day 2 - Re-read the chapter references and identify repeated words.

Day 3 - Trace the lesson theme through the Gospels.

Day 4 - Trace it through Acts and the Epistles.

Day 5 - Explain the gospel connection in your own words.

Day 6 - Discuss your conclusions with a mature believer.

Day 7 - Pray and obey the clearest application.

EXAMINE YOURSELF

1. What do I believe about Jesus Christ?
2. Have I believed that He died for my sins and rose again?
3. Am I following Him and ready for His coming?
