HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

This manual is designed for personal discipleship, mentoring, or a small group. Move prayerfully and do not rush merely to finish pages.

1. READ PRAYERFULLY Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand Scripture.	2. STUDY EVERY REFERENCE Open your Bible and read the verses around each passage.
3. ANSWER HONESTLY Allow truth to examine your heart.	4. PRAY AND APPLY Turn insight into immediate obedience.

LESSON OVERVIEW

God promised a new covenant. In it, He writes His laws in the mind and heart, becomes the God of His people, teaches them to know Him, forgives their sins, and remembers their sins no more. Jesus Christ is the mediator of the new covenant, and He established it through His blood.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Learn briefly about covenants recorded in the Bible
- Understand why God promised a new covenant
- See that Jesus Christ is the mediator
- Know the promises of the new covenant

PRAY BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Father, help me understand Your Word. Show me the truth about Jesus Christ, correct every wrong belief, and help me to believe and obey. Amen.

STUDY COMMITMENT

I will read every passage carefully, answer honestly, allow Scripture to correct me, and act on the truth God shows me.

CHAPTER 1

COVENANTS RECORDED IN THE BIBLE

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Genesis 9:8-17; Genesis 17:1-8; Exodus 24:3-8; 2 Samuel 7:12-16; Jeremiah 31:31

A covenant in the Bible joins people by promises and words that must be kept. God made covenants with Noah, Abraham, Israel, and David. The prophets later spoke of a new covenant.

COVENANTS RECORDED IN THE BIBLE

WITH NOAH	Never again destroy all flesh by flood; the rainbow was the sign.	Genesis 9:8-17
WITH ABRAHAM	A seed, land, and blessing reaching all families of the earth.	Genesis 12:1-3; 17:1-8
WITH ISRAEL	God brought Israel out of Egypt and gave His commandments.	Exodus 19:3-8; 24:3-8
WITH DAVID	David's seed would sit upon his throne; Jesus Christ is King.	2 Samuel 7:12-16; Luke 1:32-33
NEW COVENANT	Forgiveness, God's law in the heart, and His Spirit within; established through Christ's blood.	Jeremiah 31:31-34; Luke 22:20

COVENANT TRUTH

God keeps His promises. Jesus Christ is the mediator of the New Covenant established through His blood.

REFLECTION & PRAYER

Thank God for keeping His promises. Ask Him to help you come to Him through Jesus Christ, receive His promises, and live as one of His people.

CHAPTER 2

GOD PROMISED A NEW COVENANT

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES
Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 8:6-13

God said the new covenant would not be like the covenant made when He brought Israel out of Egypt, which they broke. He promised to put His law in their inward parts and write it in their hearts. He would be their God, and they would be His people.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

God said the new covenant would not be like the covenant made when He brought Israel out of Egypt, which they broke.

DISCUSS AND OBEY

1. What misunderstanding does this chapter correct?
2. What would obedience to this truth look like this week?
3. How does this truth lead me to trust, love, or follow Jesus Christ more fully?

REFLECTION & PRAYER

Where does this truth confront my present life? Pray specifically, using the language and priorities of the passages.

CHAPTER 3

JESUS CHRIST IS THE MEDIATOR

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

1 Timothy 2:5-6; Hebrews 9:15; Hebrews 12:24; John 14:6

The Bible says there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. He is the mediator of the new covenant. By means of His death, those who are called may receive the promise of eternal inheritance. We come to God through Him.

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CHAPTER 4

THE NEW COVENANT IN HIS BLOOD

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Matthew 26:27-28; Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

At supper, Jesus Christ took the cup and said, “This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.” His blood was shed for many for the forgiveness of sins. When believers eat the bread and drink the cup, they show the Lord’s death until He comes.

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CHAPTER 5

THE PROMISES OF THE NEW COVENANT

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Jeremiah 31:33-34; Ezekiel 36:25-27; Hebrews 8:10-12

God promises to put His laws into the mind and write them in the heart. He says, “I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people.” They will know Him. He will be merciful, forgive their sins, remember their sins no more, and put His Spirit within them.

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CHAPTER 6**WHAT JESUS CHRIST RESTORES****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

Romans 5:12-21; Hebrews 9:14; Hebrews 10:19-22; 1 Thessalonians 5:23;
Ephesians 5:15-16

Through Jesus Christ, God restores what sin brought through Adam. 1. **PRESENCE:** access to God. 2. **CLEANSING:** sins forgiven and conscience cleansed. 3. **RIGHT ORDER:** God works in spirit, soul, and body. 4. **AUTHORITY:** believers reign in life through Christ. 5. **LIFE AND TIME:** everlasting life and redeeming the time. We become God's own people.

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THE DISCIPLESHIP PATHWAY

This visual is a summary, not a replacement for the Scripture studied in the preceding chapters.



CLARIFY THE DIFFERENCE

What sin brought through Adam	What God gives through Jesus Christ
Separated from God	Access to God
Sin and a guilty conscience	Forgiveness and cleansing
Death reigned	Believers reign in life through Christ

SEARCH, EXAMINE, AND RESPOND

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Day 1 - Read the key passage and record what it teaches about God.

Day 2 - Re-read the chapter references and identify repeated words.

Day 3 - Trace the lesson theme through the Gospels.

Day 4 - Trace it through Acts and the Epistles.

Day 5 - Explain the gospel connection in your own words.

Day 6 - Discuss your conclusions with a mature believer.

Day 7 - Pray and obey the clearest application.

EXAMINE YOURSELF

1. Am I coming to God through Jesus Christ the mediator?
2. Is God's Word being written in my heart and obeyed in my life?
3. Am I living in what Jesus Christ has restored?

LEADER'S DISCUSSION GUIDE
