HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

This manual is designed for personal discipleship, mentoring, or a small group. Move prayerfully and do not rush merely to finish pages.

1. READ PRAYERFULLY Ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand Scripture.	2. STUDY EVERY REFERENCE Open your Bible and read the verses around each passage.
3. ANSWER HONESTLY Allow truth to examine your heart.	4. PRAY AND APPLY Turn insight into immediate obedience.

LESSON OVERVIEW

Jesus Christ says, “Follow me.” A disciple hears Him, learns from Him, obeys Him, denies self, takes up the cross daily, and continues in His Word. A disciple prays, receives power from the Holy Spirit, loves other believers, bears fruit, witnesses for Jesus Christ, and helps teach others to obey His commands.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Understand what Jesus Christ means by “Follow me”
- Learn to deny self and take up the cross daily
- Begin a life of God’s Word, prayer, fellowship, and obedience
- Understand the command to make disciples

PRAY BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Father, help me understand Your Word. Show me the truth about Jesus Christ, correct every wrong belief, and help me to believe and obey. Amen.

STUDY COMMITMENT

I will read every passage carefully, answer honestly, allow Scripture to correct me, and act on the truth God shows me.

CHAPTER 1**JESUS CHRIST SAYS, FOLLOW ME****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

Matthew 4:18-22; Luke 14:25-33; John 12:26

Jesus called Peter and Andrew, saying, “Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.” They left their nets and followed Him. Jesus also told people to count the cost. Nothing and no one should be placed above Him. A disciple is a person who follows Jesus Christ.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God’s promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

CHAPTER 2

DENY SELF AND TAKE UP THE CROSS DAILY

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES
Luke 9:23-26; Matthew 10:37-39

Jesus Christ said that anyone who will come after Him must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Him. A person who tries to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Christ will save it. Following Jesus Christ requires daily obedience.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

Jesus Christ said that anyone who will come after Him must deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow Him.

DISCUSS AND OBEY

1. What misunderstanding does this chapter correct?
2. What would obedience to this truth look like this week?

CHAPTER 3**CONTINUE IN MY WORD****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

Psalm 119:9-11, 105; Matthew 7:24-27; John 8:31-32; 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Jesus said, "If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed." A disciple hears His sayings and does them. God's Word teaches, corrects, and instructs us. We must read it, keep it in our heart, obey it, and let it guide our steps.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

Jesus said, "If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed."

DISCUSS AND OBEY

PRAY AND RECEIVE POWER FROM THE HOLY SPIRIT

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Matthew 6:5-13; Luke 18:1; John 14:26; Romans 8:26-27; Acts 1:8

Jesus Christ taught His disciples how to pray and told them always to pray. He promised that the Holy Spirit would teach them and bring His words to remembrance. The Holy Spirit helps believers pray and gives power to be witnesses for Jesus Christ.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

Jesus Christ taught His disciples how to pray and told them always to pray.

CHAPTER 5**CONTINUE WITH GOD'S PEOPLE****SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES**

John 13:34-35; Acts 2:41-47; Hebrews 10:24-25

Those who received the Word and were baptized continued in the apostles' teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, and prayers. Believers must not forsake gathering together. Jesus Christ commands His disciples to love one another; by this love people will know that they are His disciples.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

Those who received the Word and were baptized continued in the apostles' teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, and prayers.

CHAPTER 6

MAKE DISCIPLES AND BEAR WITNESS

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; 2 Timothy 2:1-3; Hebrews 12:1-3

Jesus Christ commanded His followers to teach all nations, baptize them, and teach them to obey all He commanded. The Holy Spirit gives power to be His witnesses. A disciple should share the Word, teach faithful people, endure hardship, and keep looking unto Jesus Christ.

READ AND APPLY THE PASSAGES

Read every passage carefully, including the verses before and after it. Write what it teaches about God, people, sin, Jesus Christ, faith, obedience, and God's promise. Then write one wrong belief to correct, one promise to trust, or one command to obey.

CHAPTER TRUTH

Jesus Christ commanded His followers to teach all nations, baptize them, and teach them to obey all He commanded.

DISCUSS AND OBEY

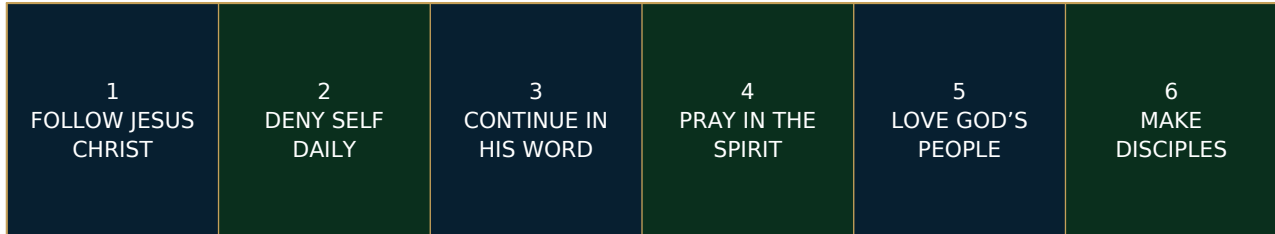

THE DISCIPLESHIP PATHWAY

This visual is a summary, not a replacement for the Scripture studied in the preceding chapters.



CLARIFY THE DIFFERENCE

A hearer only	A disciple
Hears but does not obey	Hears and does Christ's sayings
Lives only for self	Denies self and takes up the cross
Keeps silent	Bears witness and teaches others

BELT OF TRUTH

Jesus Christ says, "Follow me." A disciple hears Him, learns from Him, obeys Him, denies self, takes up the cross daily, and continues in His Word. A disciple prays, receives power from the Holy Spirit, loves other believers, bears fruit, witnesses for Jesus Christ, and helps teach others to obey His commands.

PATHWAY RESPONSE

Which stage of this pathway needs my closest attention now? What specific truth must I believe or obey before moving forward?

SEARCH, EXAMINE, AND RESPOND

SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES

Day 1 - Read the key passage and record what it teaches about God.

Day 2 - Re-read the chapter references and identify repeated words.

Day 3 - Trace the lesson theme through the Gospels.

Day 4 - Trace it through Acts and the Epistles.

Day 5 - Explain the gospel connection in your own words.

Day 6 - Discuss your conclusions with a mature believer.

Day 7 - Pray and obey the clearest application.

EXAMINE YOURSELF

1. What must I leave or change in order to follow Jesus Christ?
2. What daily time will I give to God's Word and prayer?
3. Whom can I encourage, teach, or tell about Jesus Christ?
